PeachCare for Kids

- Offers health insurance to children aged 18 and younger offering coverage for check-ups, emergency care, routine dental care, hospitalization, prescription medication, and immunizations.
- Currently, the cost per month for Peach for Kids coverage is \$11.00 to \$36.00 for one child and \$16.00 to a maximum of \$72.00 for two or more children living in the same household.
